


Northshore Mustang Club Presents Summerstang 2026 June 6th – 13th



Sunday, June 7 – Visit Jack Daniels Distillery, then on to Cherokee, NC.


Travel From Tullahoma, TN to Lynchburg, TN, where we tour the Jack Daniels Distillery, then Lunch somewhere in Tullahoma.

After lunch we will travel to Tellico Plains, TN to start our drive on The Cherohala Skyway to Robbinsville, NC then on to Cherokee, NC.







Water fun day at Nantahala Outdoor Center. White water rafting, Lunch, Tail of the Dragon (twice) then back to Cherokee.



Thursday, June 11 – Road to Nowhere, Nantahala Outdoor Center for Ziplining, then on to Fontana Dam


We will drive the Road to Nowhere from Bryson City, then go back to NOC for ziplining.


Driving Day Option 1: For those who wish to return to Cherokee from Fontana Dam.

Driving Day Option 2 – for those who want to do one more run on Tail of the dragon.




At Chilhowee you can either:

Travel to Ellijay, GA, where we will spend the night after tubing in the Cartecay River.


